# Featuring Salice Side-Mount Drawer Slides

Salice Side-Mount Drawer Slides are an economical and reliable choice for standard drawers, offering smooth 3/4-extension movement with a builtin soft-close feel.

They're ideal for simplistic, visible installations, with runners mounted directly to the sides and bottom of the drawer box.

- Extension: 3/4 (partial extension)
- Clearance: ½" (12 mm) on each side of drawer box
- · Visibility: Side and bottom of the drawer box
- Sold as: Bagged sets (left and right slides + mounting brackets)
- · Load Capacity:
- Dynamic (moving): 30 kg (≈75 lb)
- Static (at rest): up to 100 lb

#### **Tools Needed**

- · Salice 208 Side-Mount Drawer Slides (one pair per drawer)
- Mounting brackets (included)
- #6 (3.5 mm) flat-head screws
- Drill and drill bits (2.5 mm for pilot holes or 10 mm for dowel type)
- Measuring tape
- Pencil
- Level

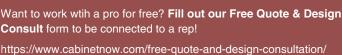

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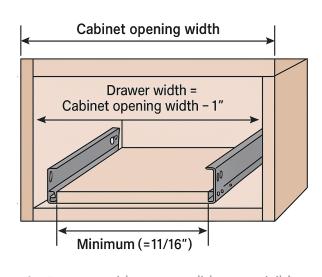


## **Step 1: Measure and Prepare the Drawer**

Before you begin, check that your drawer and cabinet opening have the correct spacing:

- Drawer width = Cabinet opening width − 1" total (½" clearance per side)
- Minimum inside cabinet clearance height: 17.5 mm (≈11/16") above and below slide line.
- Ensure the drawer box and cabinet are square and parallel for smooth operation.

Tip: Because side-mount slides are visible, keep edges clean and hardware level for a polished finish.

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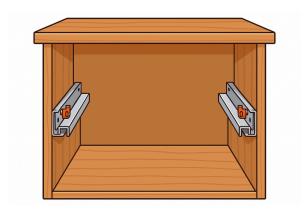
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## **Step 2: Install the Cabinet Runners**

- Measure 17.5 mm (≈11/16") up from the bottom of the cabinet and mark your runner line.
- Place each slide against the inside cabinet wall.
- Fasten with TSP #6 (Ø3.5 mm) screws through the pre-drilled mounting holes.
- Check that both runners are perfectly level and parallel to each other.

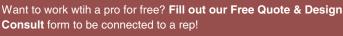
#### Optional (Knock-In Version):

- Drill Ø10 x 11 mm or Ø8 x 11 mm holes.
- Insert the dowel-mounted runners and tap gently until snug.

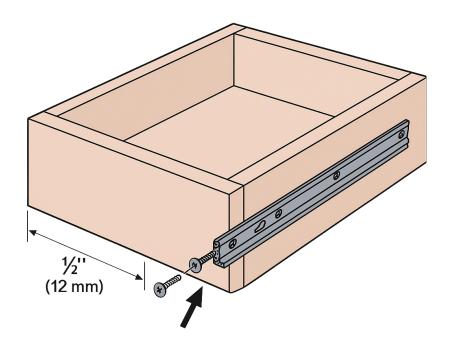






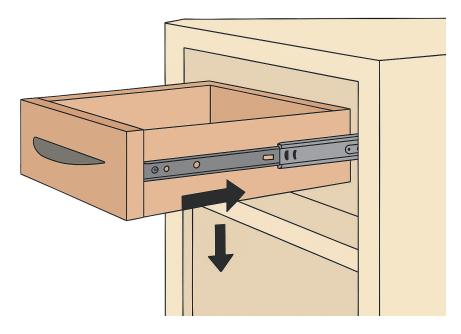
## **Step 3: Attach Slides to the Drawer Box**

- 1. Position each drawer slide flush with the bottom edge of the drawer box.
- 2. Allow a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " (12 mm) gap between the drawer and cabinet wall for each side.
- 3. Fasten using #6 (3.5 mm) screws through the holes on the runner.
- 4. Make sure the slides are even on both sides and parallel with the drawer bottom.



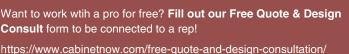
# **Step 4: Insert the Drawer**

- · Align the drawer slides with the cabinet-mounted runners.
- Carefully slide the drawer in until the safety stops click.
- Open and close the drawer several times to ensure smooth travel.
- If the drawer binds or tilts, loosen the screws slightly, realign, and retighten.

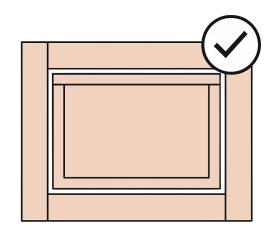






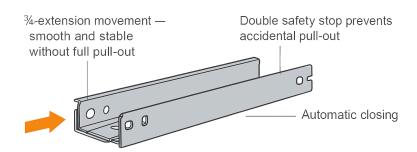
## **Step 5: Final Check**

- Confirm the drawer glides open smoothly and closes softly.
- · Ensure all screws are tight.
- Check that the drawer front sits flush with the cabinet face.
- The visible side-mount slides should be even and symmetrical on both sides.
